

Financial Contributions from 6 April 2026

Capital Limit

The capital limit remains at £23,250.

Long-term Placements

If you have £23,250 or less in capital, you will pay these minimum weekly charges until we complete your financial assessment:

- If you are of pensionable age: £206.20 per week

- If you are aged 25 to under pensionable age: £108.60 per week
- If you are aged 18 to 24 years: £88.70 per week

You will also receive a Personal Expenses Allowance of £31.80 per week.

Short-term Placement/Respite

- If you have more than £23,250 in capital and enter a care home, you must pay the full cost of your short-term stay or respite care.

- If your capital is £23,250 or less, the weekly charges are:

- Pensionable age and above: £153.10
- Aged 25 to under pensionable age: £108.60
- Aged 18 to 24 years: £88.70

Non-residential Services

Charges for these services depend on your financial assessment. The cost will be based on the actual service cost. However, day care is capped at £21.00 per day.

Flat-rate charges that do not require a financial assessment are:

- Transport: £1.80 per trip
- Day centre meals: £3.95 per meal

Self-Funders

If you pay for your own care, the costs are:

- Day care attendance: £54.85 per day

- Transport: £7.75 per trip

Intermediate Care, Transitional Beds, and Reablement

These services are free of charge.
