





Ground Floor Layout.

Orrell Mount Pavilion Additional Information

Orrel Mount Pavilion is a two-storey detached Pavilion building in 'Colonial Style' situated opposite playing fields in an established inner residential neighbourhood approximately three miles north of Liverpool city. Constructed to a traditional specification inter-war, the mansard roof has clay-tile covered hips with timber-clad dormer window and dash rendered eleven-inch cavity brick external walls, with a timber verandah running around the outer face of the building.

There is a small communal car-parking area to front and a service road to the adopted highway- Orrell Road.

Recreational facilities in the vicinity, along with local amenities such as shopping within walking distance.

Approximate Size: 482m²

Site area: Approximately 2,764m²
